IN SEARCH OF YOUNG ADULTS! SPIRITUS is



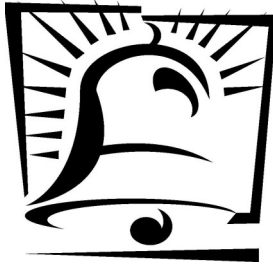
